WHAT IS THE PHILIP PROJECT?

The Philip Project is an interactive course aimed at international students and professionals. It develops skills in understanding and sharing God's Word faithfully in a variety of contexts.

WHO IS IT FOR?

The Philip Project is designed for Christian international students and graduates with an interest in understanding the Bible and sharing its message with others.

We also welcome on the course others who are living or working cross-culturally in the UK.

COURSE SCHEDULE:

All training days run from 10:00am to 4:00pm. There are three parts to each training day:

- Bible Overview and Worldviews
- Understanding the Bible - how to interpret different types of Bible literature.
- Teaching the Bible - how to prepare to teach a Bible passage.

A cooked lunch is also provided so that we can enjoy a break together in the middle of each training day.
